ach spring, The Arc, along with five other national disability organizations, presents a three-day legislative conference. The Disability Policy Seminar includes two days of high quality education about the most serious public policy issues affecting people with I/DD, preparing them to advocate at the state and local level in their home communities as well as nationally. On the third day, many participants visit Capitol Hill and meet with members of Congress and their staffers. This year's seminar will be of particular importance with the new administration and the many significant issues that Congress has expressed an interest in that will have an immediate and significant impact on people with disabilities and their families-including health care, lifeline issues such as SSI and Medicaid, and civil rights. 


